

- Abstracts must be written in English, and the submitter is responsible for checking for any typing errors.
- Abstracts should not exceed 300 words in length.
- Tables and figures are not permitted.
- There is no limit to the number of abstracts that may be submitted.
- An acknowledgment of submission will be automatically sent by e-mail to both the submitter and the presenting author upon completion of the online submission.
- **Submitters may review or modify their submitted abstracts until 24:00, February 23 (Mon), 2026 (Korea Standard Time), by visiting "My Page" on the Congress website.**
- **Notification of acceptance will be sent by e-mail to the presenting authors on March 25 (Wed), 2026.**
- Presenting authors of accepted abstracts are required to complete their registration for KSUM 2026 no later than April 22 (Wed), 2026.


